## Fiesta of Five Flags Celebration Schedule of Events: May 31 – June 9

**Pensacola, Fla. (May 22, 2012)** The Fiesta of Five Flags is the annual celebration of the founding of Pensacola by the Spanish conquistador Don Tristan de Luna in 1559. DeLuna established Pensacola as the first European settlement in the United States and since that time five different flags have flown over the city: Spanish, French, British, Confederate and American. This celebration is one of the oldest and largest heritage festivals in the state of Florida. The Fiesta of Five Flags 63<sup>rd</sup> anniversary celebration will take place May 31 through June 9.

Historic Seville Quarter comes alive with entertainment, decorations and delicious food in five rooms, each saluting our history of the flags of the five governments that have flown over Pensacola. With each ticket, guests receive access to the five rooms, two beverage tickets, an original custom designed 63<sup>rd</sup> annual commemorative pin and live entertainment throughout the venue.

**Surrender of the City** will take place at 7:15 p.m. in Phineas Phoggs. Local dignitaries such as Mayor Ashton Hayward, Police Chief Chip Simmons, Supervisor of Elections David Stafford and Pensacola Naval Air Station Commanding Officer Capt. Christopher Plummer are captured by the Fiesta Forces and surrender the City of Pensacola and its citizens to DeLuna, his queen, and the Fiesta Forces for the Fiesta season.
